

Report about the 9th Augustus De Morgan Workshop on Deontic Logic. Luxembourg 1 - 4 December 2009

From 1 to 4 December 2009 at University of Luxembourg was held the Augustus de Morgan Workshop on Deontic logic (<http://demorgan09.gforge.uni.lu/>). The aim of the workshop was to discuss the state of the art and current research trends in deontic logic in the frame of the forthcoming two volumes of the Handbook of Deontic Logic and Normative Systems edited by the chairs Dov Gabbay (Bar-Ilan University, King's College London and University of Luxembourg), John Horty (University of Maryland), Ron van der Meyden (University of New South Wales), Leon van der Torre (University of Luxembourg).

Deontic logic is of particular interest for the COST Agreement technologies action since norms are one of the workgroups of the project. Of particular interest for the COST AT action is the second volume about applications of deontic logic.
