### **COST WG4 Panel - 10 September 2012 - Vienna**

The panel was part of the scientific programme of COMMA 2012, the Fourth International Conference on Computational Models of Argument, hosted by the Vienna Centre for Logic and Algorithms, Technical University of Vienna, Austria.

The topic of the panel was "The added value of argumentation".
